WHAT TO BRING AND NOT BRING

Water Bottles

All fans will be permitted to bring in one, soft, plastic, 20 ounces (590ml), factory sealed disposable water bottle.

Fans will not be permitted to bring in hard sided, reusable water bottles.

Flags and Banners

Small flags, banners, and posters are permitted, provided they do not exceed 78in x 60in (2m x 1.5m) and must be made of a fire-resistant material.

Bag and Restricted Item Storage

FIFA will offer limited restricted item storage onsite for \$20 per item, available on a first-come, first-served basis. Golf and beach umbrellas prohibited. Mini and personal umbrellas permitted.

Strollers are not permitted onsite and must be checked into restricted item storage

There will be **no onsite storage for bikes or e-scooters**. Fans can use the free bike concierge located near Main Street–Science World Station.

GETTING TO BC PLACE VANCOUVER ON MATCH DAY

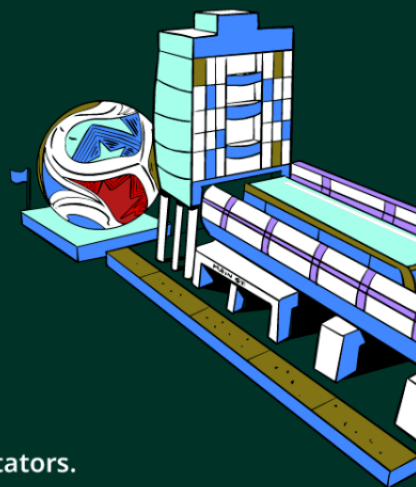
On the seven Vancouver match days, the journey begins at Main Street-Science World Skytrain Station. Spectators will enter BC Place Vancouver via Pacific Boulevard.

PUBLIC TRANSIT VIA MAIN STREET-SCIENCE WORLD STATION

- Main Street-Science World Station is on the **Expo SkyTrain line** located at the intersection of **Main Street and Terminal Avenue**. The station will be fully dressed and volunteers will be on-hand so that you know you made it to the right location.
 - If you are starting your journey from the **Millennium SkyTrain line** you can transfer to the Expo Line at Commercial-Broadway station.
 - If you are starting your journey at the **Canada SkyTrain line**, you can transfer at Vancouver City Centre Station or Waterfront Station to get yourself to Main Street-Science World.
- Extra transit service will be in place to accommodate spectators.

BIKES AND SCOOTERS

- Vancouver has **extensive bike routes** you can use for cycling, scooting or other car-free travel.
- **Free bike concierge** and valet services will be available for fans planning to arrive at BC Place Vancouver by bicycle, located at Main Street-Science World SkyTrain Station.
- Fans are encouraged to use **Mobi Bike Share**, which offers convenient docking stations throughout the city, or **Lime shared e-scooters**.

DRIVING, TAXIS AND RIDE-SHARES

- Be patient, plan ahead and allow for extra time. Expect additional **road closures**, heavy public transit use and crowding on match days.
- The **closest taxi and ride-hailing drop-off points** for visitors to BC Place Vancouver are at 1510 Quebec Street (Quebec & Terminal), adjacent to Science World and at 525 W 2nd Ave (by Olympic Village Station on the Canada Line). During busy times there may be delays.
- There is **no vehicle parking at BC Place Vancouver** and parking around the stadium will be extremely limited on match days.

MATCH DAY SPECTATOR ROUTE

The Match Day Spectator Route is a pedestrian zone for fans to gather and enjoy the pre-match atmosphere while enjoying a vibrant and distinctly Vancouver cultural experience as they make their way to the stadium. Expect live performances, DJs, soccer mini-pitch games, the FIFA merchandise store, and The Porch beer garden.

Hours of operation

The Match Day Spectator Route will open four hours before kickoff, remaining open until 30 minutes before kickoff.
