MATCH DAY IS ALMOST HERE! REMEMBER TO:

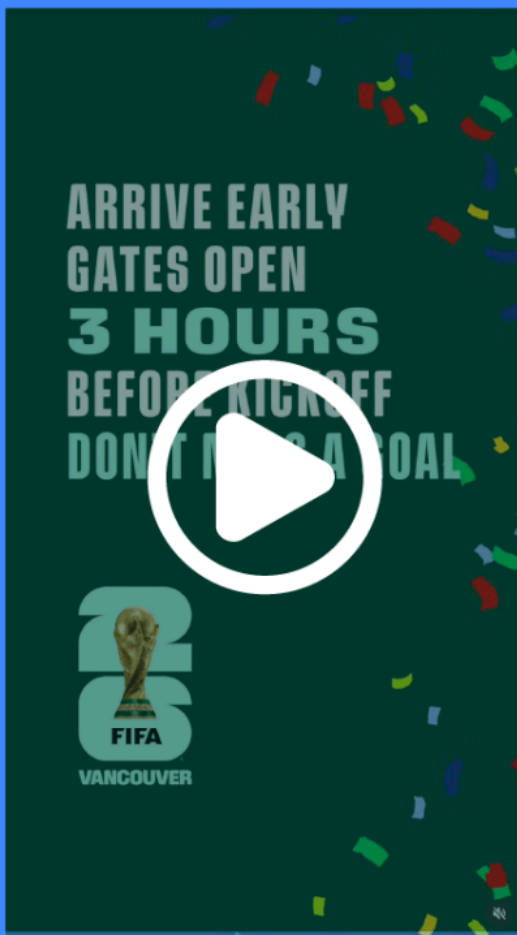
Arrive early: Match Day Spectator Route opens 4 hours before

GETTING TO BC PLACE VANCOUVER ON MATCH DAY

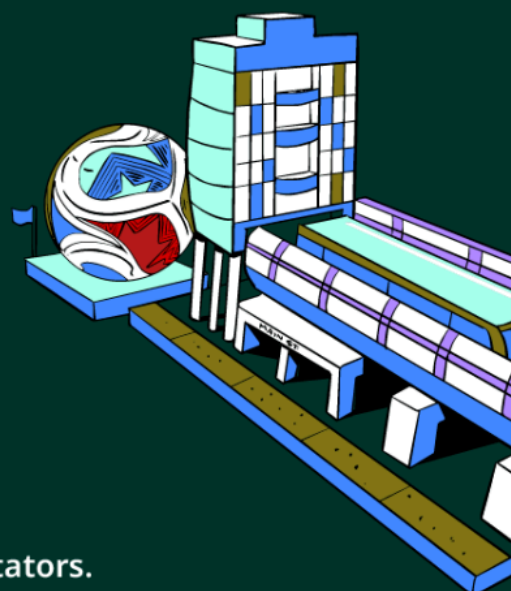
On the seven Vancouver match days, the journey begins at Main Street-Science World Skytrain Station. Spectators will enter BC Place Vancouver via Pacific Boulevard.



PLAN YOUR TRIP TO BC PLACE VANCOUVER

PUBLIC TRANSIT VIA MAIN STREET-SCIENCE WORLD STATION

- Main Street-Science World Station is on the **Expo SkyTrain line** located at the intersection of **Main Street and Terminal Avenue**. The station will be fully dressed and volunteers will be on-hand so that you know you made it to the right location.
 - If you are starting your journey from the **Millennium SkyTrain line** you can transfer to the Expo Line at Commercial-Broadway station.
 - If you are starting your journey at the **Canada SkyTrain line**, you can transfer at Vancouver City Centre Station or Waterfront Station to get yourself to Main Street-Science World.
- Extra transit service will be in place to accommodate spectators.



BIKES AND SCOOTERS

- Vancouver has **extensive bike routes** you can use for cycling, scooting or other car-free travel.
- **Free bike concierge** and valet services will be available for fans planning to arrive at BC Place Vancouver by bicycle, located at Main Street-Science World SkyTrain Station.
- Fans are encouraged to use **Mobi Bike Share**, which offers convenient docking stations throughout the city, or **Lime shared e-scooters**.

DRIVING, TAXIS AND RIDE-SHARES

- Be patient, plan ahead and allow for extra time. Expect additional **road closures**, heavy public transit use and crowding on match days.
- The **closest taxi and ride-hailing drop-off points** for visitors to BC Place Vancouver are at 1510 Quebec Street (Quebec & Terminal), adjacent to Science World and at 525 W 2nd Ave (by Olympic Village Station on the Canada Line). During busy times there may be delays.
- There is **no vehicle parking at BC Place Vancouver** and parking around the stadium will be extremely limited on match days.

MATCH DAY SPECTATOR ROUTE

The Match Day Spectator Route is a pedestrian zone for fans to gather and enjoy the pre-match atmosphere while enjoying a vibrant and distinctly Vancouver cultural experience as they make their way to the stadium. Expect live performances, DJs, soccer mini-pitch games, the FIFA merchandise store, and The Porch beer garden.

Hours of operation

The Match Day Spectator Route will open four hours before kickoff, remaining open until 30 minutes before kickoff.

WHAT TO BRING AND NOT BRING

For a full list of what you can and can't bring to BC Place Vancouver on match days, visit the **Official FIFA World Cup 2026™ app**. Under 'Stadium' select 'BC Place Vancouver', then 'Help Centre' and read 'Prohibited Items'.

Returning visitors to BC Place Vancouver should be aware that FIFA World Cup 2026™ policies differ in several ways from standard event policies.



In place of a bag check, FIFA will provide a restricted item storage option for \$20 per item that is limited and first-come, first-serve.

There will be no on-site storage for bikes or e-scooters. Strollers can be stored in the restricted items storage at a cost of \$20 per item.
