The festival will take place between June 11 and July 19, 2026, offering fans and residents a unique way to be part of this historic event. The best part? No stadium ticket is required!

COMMUNITY IMPACTS AND MITIGATION

The FIFA Fan Festival will create a great atmosphere for fans while being mindful of residents in the area. The City's goal is to deliver a world-class experience while working thoughtfully with the surrounding community.

Sound

- The City, the PNE, and experienced event partners have a plan to manage noise and disruption. Our aim is to balance a lively festival environment with consideration for nearby homes and businesses.
- Entertainment and live matches will be broadcast at sound levels similar to what residents are used to during other major events.

Access to Other Areas in Hastings Park

- To create a safe and welcoming environment, additional space and security measures are temporarily required across the Festival site.
- As part of this planning, some nearby public spaces such as the Hastings Skateboard Park, the Sanctuary, Miller Drive, Momiji Gardens and the Italian Gardens will be temporarily closed or have limited access during the Festival period.

GETTING TO FIFA FAN FESTIVAL

- All attendees are encouraged to use public transit, ride-hailing, car-share, bikes or e-scooters to access the FIFA Fan Festival.
 - There will be secure bike valet service, support for e-scooters, and other options such as Lime e-scooters and Mobi bikes available.
- No major road closures surrounding the Festival site are planned, but certain traffic measures will be in place throughout the area. This could mean localized traffic control, curb lane restrictions, and changes to on-street parking regulations.
- Parking will be extremely limited and prioritized for operations, accessible needs, and essential uses.
